

NOTICE OF CMAQ FUNDS

The Rock Hill-Fort Mill Area Transportation Study (RFATS) is accepting project applications for the FY 2021-2022 Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Improvement Program. CMAQ funds may be used for a transportation project or program that is likely to contribute to the attainment or maintenance of a national ambient air quality standard, with a high level of effectiveness in reducing air pollution. This can include:

- Alternative Fuel Projects
- Traffic Flow Improvements
- Pedestrian and Bicycle Facility Improvements
- Transit Investments

These funds must be spent within the RFATS Study Area. Projects must meet applicable federal and state guidelines as well as the criteria adopted by the RFATS Policy Committee. Applicants will also be expected to provide matching funds (20%) and letters of support from the applicable local jurisdiction (e.g. municipality or county).
